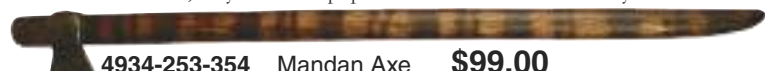

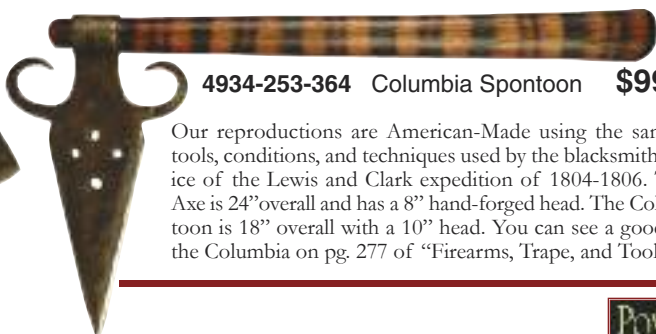

Both the Mandan and the Spontoon axes were in use before the Corps of Discovery Expedition ever reached the Missouri River tribes. When the expedition did reach these tribes, they found these two styles to be preferred amongst the tribes below the great bend of the Missouri. These tribes include the Mandan, Dakota, Iowa, Sauk, Fox, Pawnee, Comanche, Otoe, and Osage. These tribes prized the two styles very highly, above all others. So much so, they remained popular well into the 20th Century.

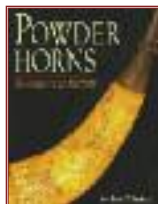

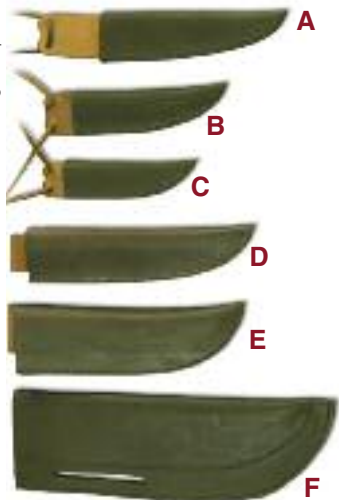

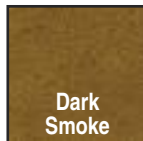
